Greenville Park: A Major Transformation Underway

Greenville Park is currently undergoing extensive renovations aimed at revitalizing the space and expanding its usability for the community.

Improvements include:

- Installation of new turf to enhance playability and durability
- Upgraded fencing for safety and security
- Modern irrigation systems to support long-term maintenance
- New BBQ areas to encourage gatherings and community events
- Digital scoreboards to support organized sports and activities
- Remodeling of concession facilities to better serve visitors

- A solar heating system that helps maintain comfortable water temperatures, especially during the early part of the swim season
