- 1. TAYLORSVILLE LIFT STATION IS APPROXIMATELY 80% COMPLETE. WAITING ON SCADA PARTS
- 2. ALL STAFF HAVE BEEN STUDYING PREPATORY BOOKS TO BECOME WATER TREATMENT, DISTRIBUTION, AND WASTEWATER OPERATORS
- 3. RENTED A TEMPORARY GENERATOR UNTIL OUR NEW ONE ARRIVES FOR TAYLORSVILLE LIFT STATION. THIS WILL SAVE US APPROXIMATELY \$8,200/MONTH
- 4. SECURITY SYSTEM PURCHASE IS IN THE FINAL STAGES
- 5. DECIDED TO PURCHASE THE SMART FLOW METERS SLOWLY. PURCHASED 20 FOR THE HOMES BEING BUILT.
- 6. PG&E HAS BEGUN WORKING ON WOLF CREEK ROAD AND KINDER AVENUES
- 7. CAL TRANS ALONG WITH THE LANDSCAPE COMPANY MARINA CONTINUE TO BEAUTIFY HWY 89 WITH PLANTS AND TREES
- 8. WAITING ON RESPONSE FROM DIG IT WITH REGARDS TO NORTH MAIN WATER LINE REPLACEMENT
- THE PARKS HAVE BEEN GIVEN A LOT OF ATTENTION. HOWEVER, I FEEL THE GRASS BALL FIELDS SHOULD BE REPLACED WITH ASTRO TURF AND ADD LIGHTING FOR NIGHTTIME GAMES
- 10. THE POOL HAS SUFFERED DAMAGE ON THE GUNITE STEPS. WE NEED TO HAVE THAT AREA FIXED BEFORE THE WINTER.
- 11. CRESCENT MILLS HAS TWO FIRE HYDRANTS THAT DO NOT WORK. WE BLACK BAGGED THEM BUT WILL REQUIRE FIXING OR REPLACING.
- 12. OUR MAINTENANCE OFFICE AND CONNEX BOXES ARE BEING RECALLED BY THE COMPANY. THE CONTRACT BEING PAID BY THE STATE HAS EXPIRED.
- 13. WE PURCHASED 4 USED CONNEX BOXES AT A FRACTION OF THE COST FOR THE EXISTING BOXES
- 14. WE MIGHT NEED TO REVISIT OUR NEW BUILDING DESIGN. MAINTENANCE DOES NOT HAVE A DESIGNATED ROOM.
- 15. WE COMPLETED LEAD AND COPPER TESTING ALONG WITH DISINFECTION BYPRODUCTS SAMPLING AND ANALYZING FOR CRESCENT MILLS AND GREENVILLE.
